THE SAAB OWNERS CLUB NATIONAL WEEKEND

SAABFEST with a difference. That is probably the best way to describe this year's Saab Owners Club meeting in the Cotswolds.

Always looking to offer our members something a little different, we have booked the Prescott Hill Climb circuit and grounds for a Saturday of show and shine, an evening meal, followed on Sunday by the opportunity for members to drive their cars up this legendary hill.

What is special about this location?

Prescott Speed Hill Climb, one of the world's most prestigious motor racing venues and home of the Bugatti Owners Club, is based just outside of Cheltenham near Winchcombe in beautiful Gloucestershire. Set in 60 acres of glorious Cotswold countryside, the estate not only provides a beautiful setting, but also hosts major motor racing championships. The 1127 yard course rises over 200 feet via short straights, fast and slow corners and a breathtaking hairpin, with the fastest modern racing cars completing the course in an exciting 36 seconds. The action can be viewed from strategic points as well as from the restaurant terrace, or you can walk the entire length of the course, through woodland and grassed areas making it ideal for picnics.

What else can we expect at Prescott?

We plan to have a large number of trade stands covering everything from parts to polish, dent repair to specialist suppliers, a food and beverage cafe and the Bugatti Museum will be open to attendees throughout the weekend. You can bring your own food as there are plenty of picnic areas, or take advantage of the hot food (including breakfast) and drinks on offer. We will have the

Club shop plus if everything goes to plan various other attractions.

So, what is happening over the weekend?

On Saturday the gates open from 9am with parking in the paddock area for those who have pre-booked. This will be our traditional Show and Shine day, with awards for the best in each class. You can browse the various Trade stands or stroll around the fascinating Bugatti Museum, which has not only cars but also Bugatti sculptures and furniture on display – museum staff will be available to answer any questions. There will also be quizzes for the children. The restaurant will be open for breakfast with food and drinks available throughout the day.

We can offer overnight camping for those who plan on staying both days.

On Sunday the gates open from 8am. Once again this is a day for you to display your car, or if you wish, to take the opportunity to attempt the hill climb at your own pace – hill climbs involve one car on track at a time, so no need to worry about other drivers and their speed. You can once again browse the various Trade stands, picnic in the grounds, or stroll around the fascinating Bugatti Museum. The main restaurant will be open for breakfast and food and drinks will be available throughout the day.

Due to limited space on the hill and evening meal, we recommend Club Members book early to avoid disappointment. More information will appear in the next issue of 'Driver'.

CAMPING

Arrival/Departure

Access to camping pitches is from 9.00am Saturday. You are requested to vacate your pitch by 16.30pm on Sunday please. Camping tickets must be shown on arrival.

Speed Limit

The speed limit on-site is 5mph. Any person found driving recklessly will be asked to leave.

Generators

Generators are allowed but cannot be used beyond 22.00.

Barbecues

Because of the danger of damaging the grassed camping area, open fires are not allowed on-site. Barbecues may be lit provided they are raised off the ground and are in a suitable container. Please ensure the smoke and fumes do not annoy other site users.

Fireworks

Under no circumstances must fireworks or other incendiary items be brought into the campsite.

Toilet Facilities

There is a block of toilets and one (1) shower at Prescott for all to use, free of charge.

Cleanliness

We make every effort to keep the site facilities clean and tidy and ask for your assistance in maintaining this standard by using the refuse and recycling bins provided.

BAR & DRINKS

The Club House Bar will be open from 6.00pm - 11.00pm to purchase beer, cider, wine, prosecco, soft drinks and juices. A selection of speciality tea and coffees will also be available.

CARS ON THE TRACK

The maximum allowable vehicle noise level is 104Db. Any vehicle that exceeds this will not be allowed to use the track at this venue.

All track users must hold a valid driving licence. The event is a non-competitive event and in this regard crash helmets are strongly discouraged.

All vehicles using the venue other than 'static display' vehicles must be insured and hold a valid license for the public highway.

This is NOT a competitive event and those driving their cars on the hill can do at their own pace. Drivers are responsible for their own cars and any damage to them or the Prescott race circuit.

THINGS TO DO NEAR PRESCOTT

You will be spoilt for choice. Within a short distance you can visit the Gloucestershire Warwickshire Steam Railway, Sudeley Castle, Tewkesbury Abbey, Pittville Park and Pump Rooms, Cheltenham Racecourse, Jet Age Museum, Cotswold Farm Park (home of Adam Hensons' farm from BBC's Countryfile), Snowhill Manor, Cleeve Hill, Hailes Abbey and Belas Knap.
